Garden Rules

The Botanical Garden is a place for teaching, research and plant species conservation. It is also a place of rest and recreation. To keep it this way, we kindly ask you to observe the following:

- Do not touch or consume plants. Certain plants in the Botanical Garden are poisonous or prickly.
- As parents or guardians, keep an eye on your children (the Garden is not a playground: no running, no hide-and-seek and the like).
- Picking, damaging, removing plants, plant parts, fruits or seeds is prohibited.
- Catching or releasing animals is prohibited.
- Entering planted areas, climbing trees, walls or rocks is prohibited.
- Bringing pets is prohibited. Assistance dogs are exempt.
- Bicycles and skateboards may not be brought into the garden.
- Filming or photography for commercial purposes is only allowed with written permission from the garden management.
- Photography for private purposes is allowed.
- Begging, busking, and art performances are prohibited.
- Please dispose of waste in the trash cans provided.
- Smoking is prohibited in the greenhouses and buildings.
- University management may ban individuals who repeatedly violate garden order.
- Garden staff is entitled to expel persons who violate the garden rules or disturb the peace in the garden and/or report them to the police.
